**WHAT COMPANY MAKES THE BENCH?** GreenTree Plastics <http://www.greentreeplastics.com/abc-program>

**HOW MANY POUNDS OF PLASTIC CAPS/LIDS DOES IT TAKE TO MAKE A 6 FT. BUDDY BENCH?** 200 lbs. (about five 55gal drums worth) amount cut in half since Sammie did project!

**WHERE CAN I SEND MY CAPS?** As much as Sammie would like to accept everyone's caps we are working on saving everyone shipping and trying to help you find someone collecting or interested in getting a bench in your local community! Sammie would love to see Buddy Benches EVERYWHERE!

**HOW DO I SORT CAPS?** Sorting is just getting out the unacceptable items such as metal and other items not on the list.

**HOW DO I GET STARTED?** Check in the files section on Sammie's Buddy Bench Project on Facebook or at [www.sammiesbuddybenchproject.com](http://www.sammiesbuddybenchproject.com). We have some printouts you can use. If you are at a school, contact your principal, make some flyers and get the word out to your community! Sammie made a Facebook video asking for help, and asked lots of businesses to collect caps! We got a lot more yes than no answers.

**WHAT KIND OF CAPS/LIDS ARE ACCEPTABLE?** There is a printable list on Sammie's website or on the GreenTree website.

**DO BENCHES NEED TO BE ANCHORED?** The groundskeeper at Sammie's school said they did not need to be anchored due to how wonderfully heavy they are!

**IS THIS THE ONLY WAY TO GET A BUDDY BENCH?** No. A Buddy Bench can be made from any material! We chose this way because the cost was less, we could recycle, involve the community and the benches are very durable and maintenance free!

**IS THERE A COMPANY NEAR ME THAT CAN MAKE IT?** Feel free to ask your local recycling/waste management. If you find someone else, please let us know and we can pass the word along to others. We can vouch that GreenTree is great!
